The ZCT, Inc. is a wholly volunteer organization that serves the Zanesville and southeastern Ohio area. It is dedicated to the production of plays, musicals and other dramatic presentations: and to the education of their members and the communities they serve in theatrical techniques and presentations.

ZCT has been performing live stage productions since 1963. The group was originally formed with a connection to the Zanesville Art Center and staged their productions at the old Liberty Theatre. In the fall of 1974, ZCT moved to Ohio University-Zanesville's Elson Hall Auditorium. During all these years, members of ACT invested the profits from the shows, and finally in March 1985, their dream was realized - the purchase of their own building! With the extensive renovation completed, the theatre was ready for the 23<sup>rd</sup> season at their current location: 940 Findley Avenue, Zanesville, nestled in the historic McIntire District.

Their history of presenting quality shows with the integrity they were written with has been their greatest strength.
